Day 1 Thursday 07 October 2021

ARRIVE QUEENSTOWN (D)

This morning we fly from Auckland to Queenstown with your Leisure Time Tour Manager. Surrounded by majestic mountains and set on the shores of crystal-clear Lake Wakatipu, the natural beauty and the unique energy of the Queenstown region create the perfect backdrop for a holiday full of adventure, exploration or relaxation. Its lake and mountain landscape is suited to almost any kind of adventure; but Queenstown is just as well-known as a place for indulgence, for wine and cuisine and for gold-mining history. On arrival into Queenstown, we meet our local driver and coach and depart for a **scenic drive alone Lake Wakatipu to Glenorchy**. Just 45 minutes from Queenstown, Glenorchy is nestled on the northern shores of Lake Wakatipu and is the gateway to hiking trails and Middle-earth magic. This rustic town is a true outdoor enthusiast's paradise. Set against a background of native beech forest and towering mountain ranges, Glenorchy's surrounds are nothing short of awe-inspiring. Enjoy some time at leisure to purchase afternoon tea here (own cost) before retracing our journey back to Queenstown to check in to our luxurious accommodation at **Millbrook Resort**. Tonight enjoy a welcome dinner at a restaurant located in the small historic village of Arrowtown.

Day 2 Friday 08 October 2021

QUEENSTOWN SIGHTSEEING (BL)

Enjoy a leisurely start today before we head into Queenstown for our excursion to Walter Peak Station. We cruise aboard the historic **TSS Earnslaw** across Lake Wakatipu to **Walter Peak High Country Farm**. Overlooking Lake Wakatipu and Queenstown's alpine scenery, the Colonel's Homestead at Walter Peak High Country Farm is the perfect place to spend a few hours. Once at the **Colonel's Homestead**

Restaurant savour the delicious aromas as the chef has the best of local produce sizzling away on the grill. Its colonial architecture and sweeping grounds evoke the elegance of a bygone era. On conclusion of our experience at Walter Peak, we'll take off by **helicopter for a scenic alpine experience!** Landing at an alpine spot we'll enjoy the sweeping views of Lake Wakatipu and surrounding mountains while enjoying **a glass of Champagne**. We land at Queenstown Airport before travelling to the famous **Gibbston Valley**. Also known as the 'Valley of the Vines', the Gibbston Valley, is one of the most scenic wine growing areas in the Southern Hemisphere. Vineyards are sandwiched, sometimes precariously, between rugged schist mountains and the rocky Kawarau River gorge. We stop at Gibbston Valley Winery for a tour and wine tasting and will be taken through the oldest vines in Central Otago, learning about the winemaking process and venturing inside New Zealand's largest wine cave. Dinner tonight is at leisure to enjoy one of the resort's restaurants.

Day 3 Saturday 09 October 2021

Today is all about relaxation so we take the day at a leisurely pace. Our day commences with a **60-minute spa package** at the award-winning **Millbrook Day Spa** – what better way to create an experience of wellness and relaxation for your mind, body and soul!
